



Consultation Results Additional NSET Day Starting from 2023/24 (all schools)



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Proposal

It is proposed that an additional In-service education and training day (INSET) be introduced across each of its five schools beginning from the next academic year. If implemented, the additional day in 2023/24 is expected to be held on 8 January 2024, with each of the Trust's schools closing to students for the day. In future years, the additional day will be allocated in the same way as the Trust sets its other INSET days (currently 2 days).

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The education sector has faced significant recent change including safeguarding and changes arising from the Department for Education's White Paper. The introduction of an additional training day would provide additional time for teaching staff to consider these changes and how they will impact the classroom. The additional time would also be used to engage with professional learning to support curriculum development, ensuring staff are able to continue to deliver the highest quality of education.

The Trust believes the additional day will improve the quality of education for our pupils and have a positive impact on their learning.

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The consultation exercise took place between the 19 June and 30 July 2023. The consultation was advertised on the Trust's website as well as each of the school's websites. Parents/guardians of each student were informed of the consultation as were staff
